KNOW THE FACTS!

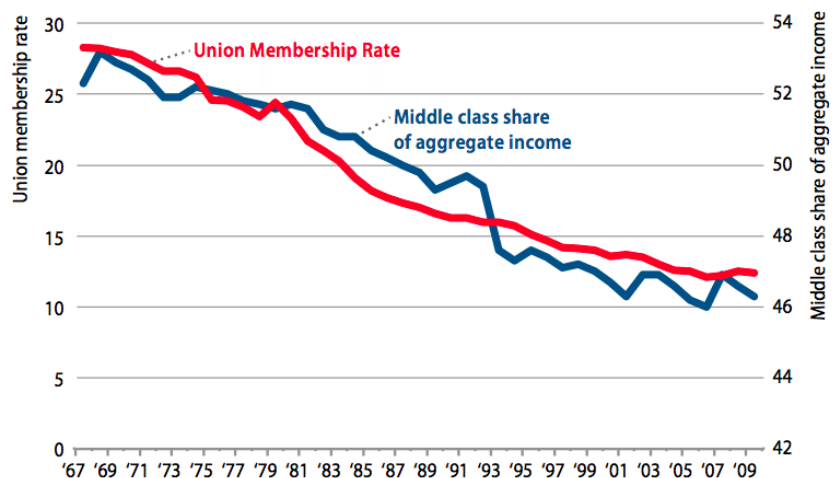
FACT: Union membership has ALWAYS been voluntary.

FACT: Your fees are not used for politics. CSUEU has a separate Political Action Committee where members can donate.

FACT: Right now, 3 in 4 CSU employees in our Union are members. That makes us a force in contract bargaining and in the Legislature. If we can get fee payers to join, we become even stronger.

- ★ Three-year contract with annual raises, one-time \$650 bonus.
- ★ State Legislature pressure to hold CSU Management more accountable.
- ★ CSUEU-sponsored legislation AB 1231 (Weber-San Diego) to restore salary steps.
