

Background:				
On occasion, a chapter officer has failed to attend meetings and fulfill any of his/her duties. Althoug the officer has abandoned the office, he/she has not officially resigned. The chapter is unable to appoint anyone to fulfill these duties, or to recover union property (files, laptops, phones, etc.). Currently, the only way to remove the officer is through an onerous and expensive recall or complaint procedure. The committee recommends this amendment to enable chapters to treat these situations as resignations upon proper notice to the officer.
